

EU declaration of conformity

This declaration of conformity is issued under the sole responsibility of the manufacturer.

Object of the declaration:

Moulded fibre egg packaging manufactured from recycled paper and cardboard, with or without label and print.

Categorisation:

The object covered by this declaration is defined by the following categories:

- Category number 2, predominant packaging material Paper/cardboard, following the definition of Annex II, Table 1 of EU 2025/40.
- Recyclability performance grade A, designed for recycling higher or equal to 95 % per unit, in terms of weighting following the definition of Annex II / Table 3 of EU 2025/40.

The object covered by this declaration complies with the applicable EU harmonisation legislation:

- Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste
- Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food
- Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)
- Regulation (EU) 1272/2013 amending Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) as regards polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons
- Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 on persistent organic pollutants
- Regulation (EU) 2024/3190 on the use of bisphenol A (BPA) and other bisphenols and bisphenol derivatives with harmonised classification for specific hazardous properties in certain materials and articles intended to come into contact with food
