

PFAS – Statement

**Valid to Hartmann European Production Units
Moulded fibre packaging material – egg packaging**

Hartmann has completed an independent laboratory assessment of representative moulded fibre packaging products from its manufacturing sites to verify compliance with the PFAS (polymeric or non-polymeric) requirements established under Article 5 of EU 2025/40 the Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR).

The laboratory assessment was performed against the PFAS thresholds defined under Article 5 of the PPWR for food contact packaging material. The test designed to confirm that the products meet the legal limits established in the regulation (EU) 2025/40:

- <25 ppb for individual non-polymeric PFAS,
- < 250 ppb for total non-polymeric PFAS,
- < 50 ppm for total fluorine (TF).

The tested moulded fiber packaging samples are representative of Hartmann's egg packaging products placed on the market. They were found to be below the applicable PPWR regulatory thresholds and therefore comply with the requirements established by Article 5 of the PPWR.

Hartmann remains committed to ensuring full compliance with all relevant regulatory requirements and to maintaining high standards of product safety and environmental responsibility.
