
California Proposition 65 Compliance Statement

This letter is Hartmann North America's response to California Proposition 65.

California Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, became law in November 1986. The current Proposition 65 list of chemicals is dated January 3, 2025.

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians (and others doing business in the State of California) about significant exposures to chemicals that are known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

This compliance statement covers Hartmann egg carton packaging of the following designs: HartTop, HartVue and Hybrid. These products manufactured by Hartmann North America do not contain the substances regulated by California Proposition 65 in concentrations resulting in exposures above the safe harbor levels determined by State of California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA). As such, these products are not required to have the California Proposition 65 warning labels.
